



# COLLECTORS CORNER



Of all the radios in my collection one of my favorites is the Jesse French model G. This set was marketed by the Jesse French and Sons Piano Co. of New Castle, Indiana and was manufactured by the Sterling Manufacturing Co. of Cleveland, Ohio, one of the oldest and largest makers of electrical instruments at this time, having been in business since 1906. They entered the radio manufacturing field in 1929.

The Jesse French Junior was introduced in June of 1930 when the craze for midget radios, as they were called, was sweeping the country. It retailed for \$69 complete. The set weighs 33 pounds, measures 19" high, 14" wide, and 9" deep. The cabinet is of burl walnut veneer. The base and trim are solid poplar. This same chassis was used in the Jesse French "Queen Anne", an unusually styled console table of early English design. Identical chassis were used by Sterling in their own mantel set "The Little Symphony", and in the Sears-Roebuck "Meteor" model H and the Belknap Hardware and Supply Co. model G mantel radio.

A couple of unusual features stand out in the TRF circuit. Type 24's are used in the 2 RF stages. Another is used in the Loftin-White detector amplifier directly coupled to a 45 output tube driving an 8" Rola dynamic speaker. An 80 rectifier provides direct current for the circuitry.

In vogue in 1930-31, the Loftin-White amplifier was used in a small number of radios, but mainly in PA amplifiers. Advantages of compactness, simplicity, excellent detector action and high audio gain were claimed. Also, because of the hum-bucking ability of this circuit, very little filtering of the power supply was needed and excellent tone was obtained.

The tandem volume control also is worthy of note. It simultaneously acts on the antenna coil and screen grid voltage of the RF tubes to obtain smooth and complete regulation of all signals.

Although a well designed set, the model G is prone to some problems. Buried in the 4" deep chassis the transformer commonly burns out due to overheating and shorted filter capacitors. Because of the nearly 500 volts of B+ used by the Loftin-White circuit, 600 volt filter capacitors should be used for replacements.

Trouble with the dual volume control is also common. A break in the wire wound control may be fixed by inserting as small a piece of aluminum foil as possible between the wire elements and the insulation, which will close the circuit again. Broad tuning is caused by a set screw at the back of the tuner needing tightened.

After overhaul the Jesse French Junior is an exceptionally fine sounding radio compared to its peers, perhaps because of the Loftin-White circuit. It's a very sensitive set but like all TRF's it is not very selective.







At the Canandaigua A.W.A. meet I talked with quite a few collectors about this column and from everyone I received favorable comments about it. Many people have begun asking me about a particular radio they own and frequently I am able to help them on appraisals, identification of the set, or some other fact. If any of you have questions about a certain radio, please contact me with a SASE for reply. This month I shall cover the "B's and C's", and remember these prices are a guide only, as prices will vary according to condition, collector demand, and many other factors.

Received a letter from Raymond Thompson of Maryland with these comments. He said...."I saw your article (October issue) concerning pricing of sets, they looked reasonable except for the model 5 A.K. breadboard. I know of one A.K. 5 with tags that sold for \$2400 in 1979, and another recently for \$1800. I have never seen one for the price you mentioned. Most of the collectors I know wouldn't even consider selling theirs for \$1500. If you ever find one for that amount I would be interested." Reply.... On a model as rare as the A.K. 5 there is no ceiling on the price a collector would pay to complete their A.K. collection. As far as supply and demand, there is far more demand than supply. Incidentally an A.K. 5 without tags is worth \$1000.



IT SOLD FOR \$20, AND EMPLOYED THE FAMOUS WOODEN "BOOK-TYPE" CONDENSER FOR TUNING. THE HOLE IN THE LID WAS FACTORY INSTALLED TO FIT THE HEIGHT OF WD-11 TUBES WITH THEIR ADAPTORS WHEN USED.


