




2022 Floor Plan



Huntsville offers many area dining options across the city. For out of town guests, the list below are venues we can recommend either within walking distance from the nearby hotels, or a few minute drive from the Hamfest.

5 Minute Walking Distance from Embassy, Springhill, & Homewood Suites

Rhythm on Monroe – Rooftop bar & restaurant, featuring locally-sourced ingredients, Rhythm's menu provides delicious urban fare, craft brews, a curated wine list, and handmade cocktails. 700 Monroe St SW, Huntsville, AL, 35801 (above VBC North Hall)

Pan e Vino – Gourmet Pizza, Italian food & Craft Beers. Stylish, indoor/outdoor pizzeria at the Huntsville Museum of Art, overlooking Big Spring Park 300 Church St SW, Huntsville, AL 35801 (follow walkway around lake)

A short drive SW on Clinton Ave

Straight to Ale & Ale's Kitchen – local brewer taproom and Ale's Kitchen serves gourmet burgers, wings, fresh cut fries. Also featuring American, Asian Fusion, Barbecue, Burgers, Korean, Mexican, Middle Eastern, Sandwiches, Southern and Tex-Mex style cuisine.

Yellowhammer Brewing Co & Earth And Stone Wood Fired Pizza, local brewer taproom with counter service for pizza, salads, calzones, desserts.

Rock & Roll Sushi – Excellent traditional sushi, rolls, and Japanese dishes from the kitchen. Huntsville Chairman's favorite.
