TV 110UK/TV 144UK Sony black and white portables come in two sizes and two colours. An 11" or 14" tube. And a classy white or sleek black cabinet.

Below is the TV 110. A solid state set weighing in at 15 lbs 7 oz. On the opposite page is the TV 144. Another solid state set that weighs just 18 lbs 12 oz.

Which means you won't have to buy a body building course before you buy either of our sets. They really are easy to carry around.

So you can have television in the living room, television in the kitchen, even the midnight movie in the bedroom.

And if your other half wants to get some shut eye, don't worry.

All our black and white portables come with a personal earphone.

You can even take our little tellys out in to the wild.

Because whether you're cruising down the river or just out cruising in the car, when you pull up you'll find our tellys run off a 12 volt battery as well as mains or can be plugged into the cigarette lighter socket in your car when used with our optional DCC 2AW car battery cord.

Finally, they all have a special loop antennae and an external aerial socket to receive all three channels loud and clear.

Like all Sony colour televisions, it uses the famous Trinitron system that gives you a clear, sharp and truly lifelike picture.

And what's more, it's as portable as our black and white portables.

It can run off a car/boat battery or optional rechargeable battery pack (as illustrated on the facing page). And since it weighs just 20 lbs (without battery pack), you don't have to be a bionic man to carry it.

It comes with a telescopic aerial, personal earpiece and mains lead. And it has all the controls our big sets have. Picture brightness, colour and hue controls and automatic colour and AFT switches to help you get the best reception possible.

You might buy the KV 9000 for a second set.

Somehow we think it'll probably be watched more than your first set.

You can watch the midnight movie in the bedroom. And fall asleep there instead of in your armchair.

KV 1820UB Our 18" model incorporates the new Trinitron Plus System.

Quite simply, this cuts down the amount of reflected light which is notorious for lessening the contrast on T.V. sets.

The result is a clearer, sharper picture.

The 2.30 at Newmarket will look just as good in a light room as the midnight movie does in a dark room.

And you may notice smaller things. Like a wrinkle in a newsreader's face you hadn't spotted before. (Our sincere apologies to all newsreaders.)

The set is available in a Teak or Rosewood finished cabinet and features push button tuning and sliding controls for volume and contrast.

Again, there is a childproof panel hiding colour, brightness and tone controls away from five year old would-be T.V. engineers.






KV 2000UB If you want a slightly bigger picture, maybe you should take a look at the KV 2000.

It's a 20" set available in either Teak or Rosewood finished cabinets.

Again, it incorporates the new Trinitron Plus System with features like push button tuning, sliding controls, a childproof panel hiding colour, brightness and tone controls.



The Sony Trinitron System Nine years ago we invented an entirely new colour system and slapped a patent on it.

It's called the Trinitron System and only Sony can use it.

It works quite simply. Instead of the customary three small electron lenses, Trinitron uses just one large one. By focusing the colour beams through the centre of the lens, we can produce a picture unrivalled for sharpness and clarity.


We can also produce a brighter picture. Because we have something we call an Aperture Grille. It's made up of slots, not holes, which allow more of the colour beams to reach the screen.

The Sony Trinitron Plus System On our larger sets to overcome the problem of reflected light, we use our new Trinitron Plus System which gives the picture even greater contrast.

What we've done is paint the finest black lines between the phosphor stripes and made the smoked filter screen lighter.

Result? A clearer, sharper picture, even in a bright room.

But maybe the real beauty of our system lies in its solid state circuitry and low running temperature. For it is these things that go to make the Trinitron so reliable.

AN 55-B2 Our unique independent parabolic aerial can be used on all the colour T.V.'s in this brochure. Also available is the AN 55-B3 which can be fitted to an aerial mount at the rear of the set. These aerials will give the best possible indoor performance.*

SU 440-20 This modern T.V. stand is finished in brushed aluminium. With a reversible Teak/Rosewood cross tail it is designed for use with the KV 2000. Also available in the same design but for use with the KV 1820 is the SU 440-18.



SU 420-18 Another T.V. stand available in a Chrome and Teak/Rosewood finish, designed for use with the KV 1820. Also available in the same design, but for use with the KV 2000, is the SU 420-20.
